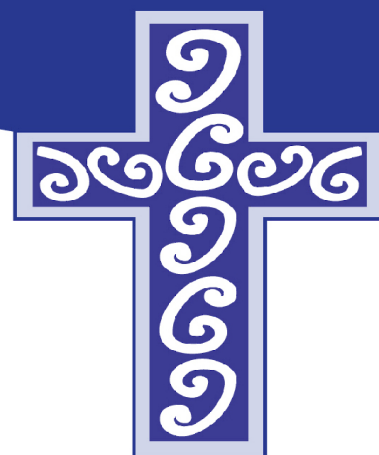

2018 School Account Breakdown

Attendance Dues

Attendance Dues are a compulsory payment under the terms of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 and a condition of enrolment at Marist School Mt Albert. Attendance Dues are charged for all students who attend Catholic Schools in New Zealand.

Your Attendance Dues are used to repay loans for building works done at schools in the Auckland Diocese, property related costs including school building works, buildings insurance and costs directly associated with the administration of attendance dues.

Attendance Dues are collected by Marist School on behalf of the school's Proprietor, the Roman Catholic Bishop of Auckland. The attendance dues collected by Marist School are forwarded to Auckland Common Fund Limited, a company established by the proprietors of Catholic integrated schools in the Diocese of Auckland responsible for the collection of attendance dues.

The charge for 2018 for primary school children is \$430.00 incl GST.

Catholic Special Character Donation*

The Catholic Special Character contribution is a voluntary donation of \$12.50 per term (\$50.00 per annum) per student. This contribution provides the main source of funding for all services provided to Marist School Mt Albert by the Catholic Education Services Board. No contributions are made by the Government for these services. The Catholic Education Services Board assists schools to provide a Catholic education for your child through the preservation and enhancement of the Catholic Special Character in our schools.

Board of Trustees Contribution*

The Board of Trustees encourages every family to contribute to funding the school via payment of the BOT Contribution. The Board uses these funds to ensure your child receives the very best in education and to ensure the school is able to provide the resources to support our learning programmes.

Religious Education Curriculum Development Levy*

The RE digital resource produced by the National Centre for Religious Studies provides digital lessons to support each strand of the RE curriculum.

Activity fee is charged for activities for the year including performers, trips and other activities to support the curriculum.

Stationery has been purchased this year via our school supplier and we have passed the very competitive prices on. Each child was issued stationery on the first day of school. We have already paid our suppliers and would appreciate prompt payment.
