- About and people they know in church who are part of their family- whanau, school, parish or wider church who bear the Fruits on the Holy Spirit by their words and actions. Eg Mum bears the fruit of love when she hugs me.

We know that the best way to improve our reading ability is s by reading more! It is really important that you read every day.


This term your goal should be to read more than last term!
