WHAT IS IT?

Our first casino night is the school's biggest fundraising event for the year. It is an elegant evening with the theme of 'Casino Royale'. It is a fancy dress occasion. A professional company is providing casino style tables and games that comes with 'Marist Money' for the table games.

HOW DO I BOOK A TEAM?

Fill in the booking form and drop it off at the school office along with your cash payment or circle internet payment and bank straight to our account, see the front for details. Alternatively you can email Donna deqfamily@gmail.com

WHO IS IT FOR?

The event raises money for the school, our kids, and their facilities. This year the fundraiser will allow the Marist PTFA to provide support towards our renovations – namely landscaping and other outdoor improvements.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you've been to a PTFA quiz or comedy night you'll recognise the format. Each team of 8 or 10 people picks a team name. There is a spot prize for the best dressed, and the teams with the most money at the end of the evening will enter a play off for a grand prize. The event is designed to be a fun event that anyone can participate in. Even if you don't know a blackjack table from a roulette wheel, you'll still find heaps of fun things to do.

WHAT IS THE PROGRAMME FOR THE EVENT?

Doors open at 7pm. There will be prize draws as well as live and silent auctions throughout the evening. Prizegiving will be approx. 10.15pm, followed by music and dancing (optional) till late.

IS FOOD AND BEVERAGE AVAILABLE ON THE NIGHT?

Yes! But there will not be pizza orders this year because the ticket price includes a light but delicious supper as well as nibbles on arrival. Alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks are available at a bar. You can pay by cash or Eftpos. Water is free of charge

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T HAVE ENOUGH PEOPLE TO FORM A TEAM?

No problem – let us know and we will connect you with other families from our school community. There are always teams that need more people! The class reps are also organising a team for each class.

WILL THERE BE RAFFLES?

Yes, you can buy a 'lucky number'. Once purchased this number is yours for the night and valid for every prize draw. You will see people circulating and selling lucky numbers throughout the evening.

HOW DO THE AUCTIONS WORK?

There are two types of auctions, live auctions and silent auctions. Live auctions are run by a professional auctioneer. Silent auctions can be found around the perimeter of the hall and you simply write your name and price on an auction sheet. These remain visible throughout the evening and the highest written bid at the end of the night wins.

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT AUCTION ITEMS ARE AVAILABLE?

There are many prizes, items, and experiences – big and small – up for grabs. A catalogue will come home with your child approximately one week before the casino night.

CAN I BID IF I'M NOT THERE?

WHAT HAPPENS IF I RUN OUT OF MARIST MONEY?
