

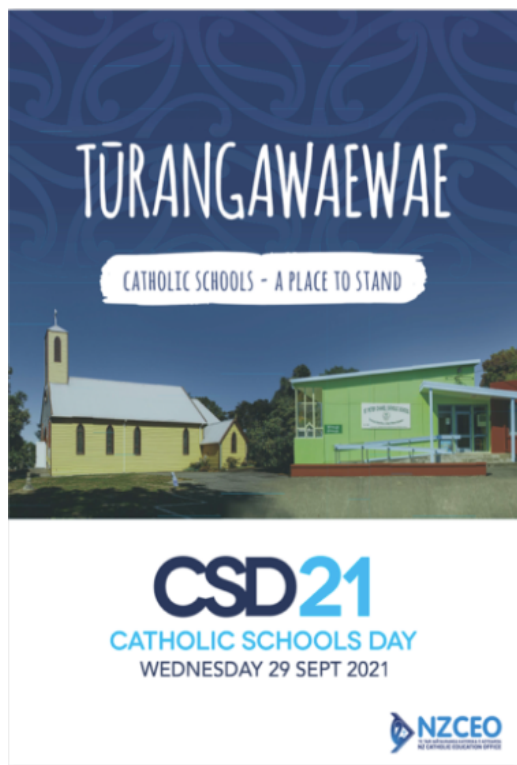
Marist School Community Update – 27.09.21

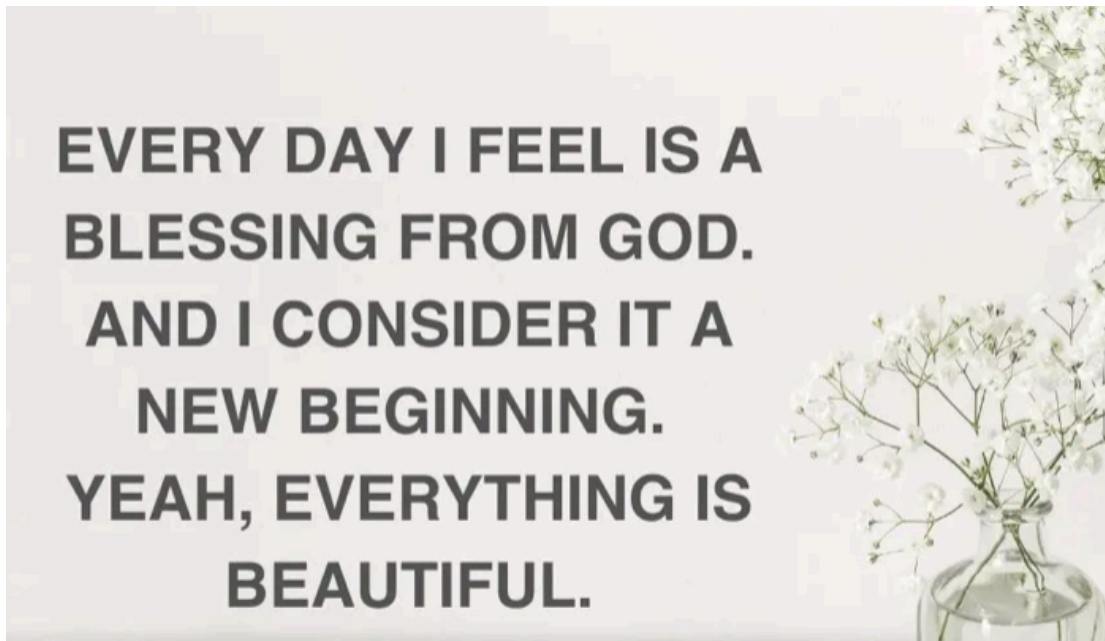
