If you'd like to talk with one of the Senior Leadership Team please email us and we'll give you a call.

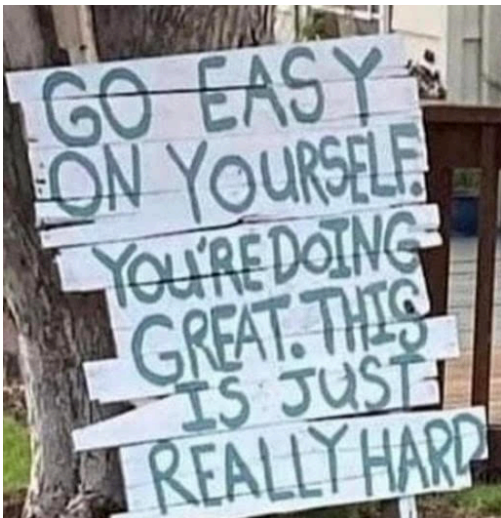
